2 On March 21, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., the parties appeared in Department 10 of the above-
3 captioned Court on the joint *ex parte* application filed by Defendant and Cross-Complainant City
4 of San Buenaventura (Ventura) and Cross-Defendants Casitas Municipal Water District (Casitas),
5 the City of Ojai (Ojai), Ventura River Water District (VRWD), Meiners Oaks Water District
6 (MOWD), the Wood-Claeysens Foundation (Foundation), Ventura County Watershed Protection
7 District (Watershed Protection), and the Rancho Matilija Mutual Water Company (Rancho
8 Matilija) (all collectively Moving Parties) for an order continuing the stay in this action for six (6)
9 months to September 30, 2023. The appearances of the parties are as noted in the record. Having
10 read and considered all of the pleadings, supporting declarations, and evidence admitted, and
11 having heard argument of counsel, and good cause appearing therefore, the Court finds that a
12 continuance of the stay is necessary to allow the parties to continue to negotiate terms of a
13 potential global or partial settlement with Mediator David Ceppos. Therefore, the stay in this
14 case is continued for all purposes consistent with the original stay for six (6) months to September
15 30, 2023.
