Notice hereby given that we the undersigned
have this day located and do claim a water right
to the extent of 1500. one thousand five hundred inches
of water measured under a four inch pressure for the
purpose of milling manufacturing irrigation and
domestic purposes. said water right is located
on the San Buenaventura River and more particu-
larly described as follows to wit commencing at
or near the water Ford now used in crossing the
San Buenaventura River west of and near to
Don Morago's house situated in La Canada
Largo Valley and conveyed from thence along the
easterly side of said River by ditch or flumes
or both, constructed four feet wide at bottom
five feet wide at top and three feet deep in size
to the point of hill dividing what is known as
Ventura Valley from La Canada Largo Valley
