а	Describe any water conservation efforts you have initiated	The City of Ventura issued a Stage 3 Water Shortage Emergency in 2014 and has adopted a water waste ordinance to institute outdoor watering restrictions and other water waste restrictions to achieve a 20% water use reduction goal as well as implementation of a 4 tiered rate structure. The City also has a customer assistance program where customers may acquire free water conservation aids such as low-flow showerheads, kitchen faucet aerators, leak detection kits, and toilet flappers. The City has also instituted a Water Conservation Survey Program where customers can receive a free survey to help them reduce water use indoors and out. The City has also developed a Water Efficiency Incentive program for customers to apply for funding to perform turf removal or irrigation efficiency at their property. In addition the City is a signatory to the CA Urban Water Conservation Council (CUWCC) and has submitted an Urban Water Management Plan every 5-years to the State since 1985.
