2 WHEN I GO TO THE THIRD LISTED ENTITY, WHICH IS A 3 FICTITIOUS ENTITY WITH AN AGENT FOR SERVICE, THE 4 CROSS-DEFENDANT IS 1970 RANCH ROAD, LLC. THE AGENT, WHO 5 YOU'RE TRYING TO REACH IS FRED F. MASHIAN, M-A-S-H-I-A-N. YOU'VE GOT AN ADDRESS ON SUNSET BOULEVARD HERE IN 6 7 LOS ANGELES WITH A UNIT OR APARTMENT NUMBER, BUT WHAT UPS 8 HAS TOLD YOU, ACCORDING TO WHAT MS. PROCK HAS PROFFERED, 9 IS THAT THE INTENDED RECIPIENT HAS MOVED AND UPS IS 10 ATTEMPTING TO FIND A NEW DELIVERY ADDRESS FOR YOU, BUT 11 THAT DOES NOT SHOW DELIVERY TO MR. MASHIAN.

12 SO NOW THAT GIVES ME PAUSE BECAUSE WITHOUT ANY 13 FURTHER EFFORT TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF WHAT OTHER SKIP 14 TRACING MIGHT FIND A NEW ADDRESS FOR MR. 6 THEN THE NEXT DILIGENCE AFFIDAVIT I GET ISN'T AN 7 EVADING ONE BASED ON THE STREET ADDRESS. IT IS YOUR FIRST 8 LISTED ENTITY FOR PEOPLE WHO LIVE BEHIND A LOCKED GATE 9 BECAUSE YOU'RE TRYING AT THIS POINT TO SERVE A CERTAIN 10 JAMES PENDLETON, WHO IS ACTUALLY THE SECOND OF TWO ENTRIES 11 FOLLOWING HIS SPOUSE PRESUMABLY, ADREA PENDLETON, WHO IS 12 THE FIRST OF ENTRIES OF LOCKED GATE PEOPLE.
